The municipality helps residents with a low income or debts

If your child goes to school you can receive money each school year to help cover the costs for children up to the age of 18 years

For example, you can receive money for:



A computer



A bicycle



Expenses, such as the cost of an excursion or a book bag, pencils and pens.

Even if you don't have money for sports or music lessons, your child can still participate



If your child would like to play a sport, learn to swim or go to music lessons, the Jeugdfonds Sport & Cultuur Noord-Holland (Youth Fund for Sports & Culture North Holland) will cover the membership or cost of lessons.



If your child needs extra equipment such as sports shoes or clothing, or a musical instrument, you can receive a voucher for these via the Jeugdfonds. You can then exchange the voucher for the items at the shop.

Please note: you should apply for support first, before purchasing items or incurring other costs.
